


BEST PRACTICE OF KHOWANG COLLEGE 2020-21



CASE 1:

1. TITLE OF PRACTICE: AN ONLINE LECTURE SERIES.

2. Objective of the Practice:

- i. To find alternatives to face-to-face instructor.
- ii. To develop the quality of teaching-learning situation in online education.
- iii. To convene the learning style or needs of students by online education.
- iv. To develop the efficiency and effectiveness of teaching and developing by online education

3. The Context that required initiation of the practice: The whole educational system has been collapsed during the lockdown period of the Novel Corona Virus Disease 2019 not only in India but across the globe. As a result, online teaching and learning have been used by teachers and students on an unprecedented scale. In other words, the Covid-119 crisis has obliged most education system worldwide to adopt alternatives to face-to-face instruction.

4. The Practice: During the Covid-19 lockdown period, the department of Assamese of the College, organized an online lecture series for the greater interest of the students' community. Two lectures held in that series - on 13th June, 2021 and the 27th June, 2021. On the first day, Dr. Pranjit Bora, Assistant Professor of Assamese Department of Dibrugarh University delivered a speech on "World Literature: What, Why and How?" and on the second day, Dr. Sanjib Pol Deka, Assistant Professor in Assamese Department of Tezpur University delivered a lecture on "Reading and Re-Reading the History of Assamese Literature."

5. Evidence of Success: More than 100 students participated in the lecture series, found it quite interesting and highly benefitted by the deliverance of the resource persons.

6. Problems Encountered: The participant students faced some difficulties during the online lecture series. In spite of their enthusiasm, some students without reliable internet access and/or technology had to struggle to participate the lecture series.

CASE 2:

1. TITLE OF PRACTICE: FREE BOOK-GIFTING PROGRAMME



2. Objective of the Practice:

- i. To inspire the students of the college and the nearby educational institutions to incubate and develop the habit of reading books.
- ii. To instill practice thinking among the students.

3. The Context: Reading is a very good habit that one needs to develop in life. Reading is useful for overall well-being of a student. There is no better companion than a good book. A good book can inform, enlighten and lead a student in the right direction. Thus reading has several positive effects on the mind, body and soul of the reader. Keeping in mind, all their virtuous qualities of reading, a free book-gifting programme was organized in the college.

4. The Practice: “Polox” – a literary forum of Department of Assamese and Department of English, in collaboration with Khowang College Students’ Union organized a free book-gifting programme named “Grantha Uphar” on the 16th of February 2021 on the auspicious occasion of Swaraswati Puja.

5. Evidence of Success: Selected literary pieces from both Assamese and English literature were distributed among more than 100 book lovers. The programme was formerly inaugurated by the honourable principal of the college. In addition to this, the first issue of the poetry collection, “Chouhodor Kobita”, a monthly publication of a collection of poem which is also an initiative, “Polox”, was inaugurated by the Principal of the College.
