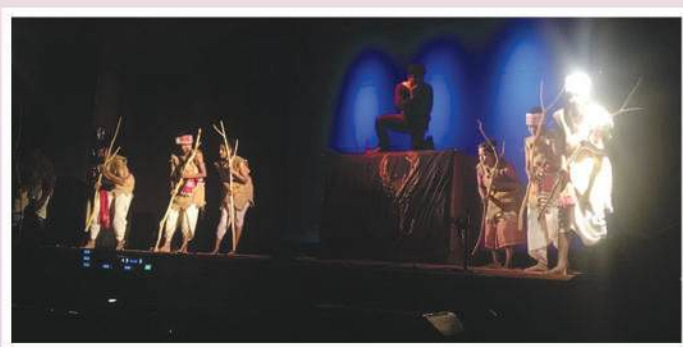
A FIVE- DAYS WORKSHOP ON DHOL BADON
