## A FIELD SURVEY ON SANITATION STATUS OF EIGHT (8) VILLEGES IN KOLOWLOWA G.P. UNDER KHOWANG DEVELOPMENT BLOCK.

The members of Khowang College Health and Sanitation Club under took a commendable effort by doing a field-survey in eight villages of Kolowlowa G.P. under Khowang Development Block, viz. (1) Dulia Tea Estate, (2) Kolowlowa Deori Gaon, (3) Chenimari Gaon, (4) Athabari Gaon, (5) Chamua Gaon, (6) Betoni Majgaon, (7) No. 1 Buri Khowang, and (7) Cherepakhati Gaon. The motto of the survey work was to get the sanitation status of the villagers of the surveyed areas and to make them aware about their health and hygiene. For this purpose, a suitable questionnaire was made for collecting information. The survey was conducted randomly in sample households of the villages under survey.

The table reveals that the inhabitants of the surveyed areas are yet to avail complete sanitation so far, their toilet facilities are concerned. It is unfortunate that among the eight surveyed villages, the open defecation practice is still prevailing to some extent in two villages, viz-(1) Dulia Tea Estate, and (2) Kolowlowa Deori Gaon, areas almost inhabited by tea garden labourers and tribal people respectively. Besides in Dulia Tea Estate, most of the latrines provided by the management were found to be out of order. The Kuchha latrines are also not hygienic so far in both the aforesaid areas. The condition of toilets was also filthy. It's also found that in all the villages, except Dulia Tea Estate, the major portion of villagers have availed sanitary toilets through Govt. Schemes which is really a praiseworthy effort of the Govt.

It was also found in the survey that so far the sources f drinking water of the villagers are concerned, almost all of them make arrangement of tube wells for the same. The underground water definitely contains iron beyond the safety levels which really causes health hazards for the villagers.

Gandhi said, "India lives in its villages." So, in order to upgrade India in the eye of the world, the condition of the villages and villagers must be improved. The toilet facility of the villagers should be improved by making provisions for water near toilet seats. Moreover, in view of existence of iron in water of tube wells, necessary arrangements should be undertaken for removing iron from water. The Government, no doubt, should play the role of

a booster to promote the sanitation status of the villagers and to make India a complete open defecation free nation within its stipulated period.

Khowang College Health and Sanitation Club, in its two days survey, tried its utmost to create awareness among the villagers of the surveyed areas about cleanliness and sanitation and urged the villagers to be instrumental in making India a CLEAN, GREEN & HEALTHY 'UTOPIA.'
